Re: California Proposition 65 Warning Labeling Requirements

Dear Valued Customer,

The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, better known by its original name of Proposition 65, requires businesses to notify Californians about chemicals in the products they purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By providing this information, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about protecting themselves from exposure to these chemicals. This list of chemicals, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include more than 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

Businesses are required to provide a "clear and reasonable" warning before knowingly and intentionally exposing anyone to a listed chemical. This warning can be given by a variety of means, such as World Dryer has chosen to label our products with "on product labeling". As a customer, you may see these warnings because the product can ship from a number of locations including the State of California.

Hand and hair dryers manufactured and sold by World Dryer (including World Dryer, American Dryer, Nova and Electric-Aire brands) will include the "on product labeling" shown below.

Proposition 65 does not ban or restrict the use of the chemicals on the list, many of which can be found in a variety of metal, rubber, and plastic components. Proposition 65 can be categorized as a "Right to Know" law, and Proposition 65 warnings are not an indication a product is violating safety standards or regulations. Rather this warning means the business issuing it is aware, or believes, that one or more listed chemicals may be present in the product, even if only in trace amounts.
